S.H.I.N.E. – Shine for Jesus, Share His Light!

S – Share Jesus' Story

"Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation." – Mark 16:15

Action Idea: Draw a picture or make a short video telling a story about Jesus—then send it to a friend or relative.

Say a few words: "Jesus loves you so much – He's amazing!"

H – Help with a Happy Heart

"Serve one another humbly in love." – Galatians 5:13

Action Idea: Help with chores at home, write a note to cheer someone up, or collect toys or clothes to give to others in need.

Say a few words: "I helped because Jesus fills me with joy!" (Give them a hug!)

I – Include Others

"Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you." – Romans 15:7

Action Idea: At school, church, or online, find someone who might feel left out and invite them to join in.

Say a few words: "Would you like to join us? You're welcome!"

N – Notice God at Work

"Taste and see that the Lord is good." – Psalm 34:8

Action Idea: Keep a "God sightings" journal or draw pictures of how you see Jesus bringing light, hope, or peace in your life.

Say a few words: "Wow – that was Jesus helping us!"

E – Encourage Everyone

"Encourage one another and build each other up." – 1 Thessalonians 5:11

Action Idea: Write or record a message of encouragement for someone who's sad, worried, or just needs a smile.

Say a few words: "Jesus cares about you. I do too!" (Give them a hug!)
