THE 2BC SECRET:

'I AM GOD'S FAVORITE, HE LOVES ME THE BEST...'

Let's use these declarations to remind us about God's promises and our Identity as 2BC Champion Children, Families and Churches.

Light — "We declare Jesus is our Light! We will never walk in darkness — we carry His light everywhere we go!" "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8:12)

Shine — "We declare we are the light of the world! Like a city on a hill, we cannot be hidden!" "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden." (Matthew 5:14)

Belonging — "We declare children belong on Jesus' team! He welcomes us with open arms — the Kingdom of Heaven is ours!" "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." (Matthew 19:14)

Childlike — "We declare our childlike faith opens Heaven's door! Jesus calls us to trust Him simply, just like a child!" "Unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 18:3)

Known — "We declare God never gives up on us! He knows and loves every child and wants each one to belong to Him." "Your Father in heaven is not willing that any of these little ones should perish." (Matthew 18:14)

Beloved — "We declare we are truly children of God! The Father lavishes His great love on us — young and old!" "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!" (1 John 3:1)



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Voice — “We declare we hear our Shepherd’s voice! We know Him, and we joyfully follow wherever Jesus leads us!” “My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.” (John 10:27)

Word — “We declare God’s Word lights our path! The Bible guides every step we take, today and always!” “Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.” (Psalm 119:105)

Forgiven — “We declare every sin is forgiven through Jesus! We are free, clean, and fully loved — no guilt, no shame!” “God made us alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins.” (Colossians 2:13)

New — “We declare we are brand new in Jesus! The old is gone — a fresh, beautiful new life has begun!” “If anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: the old has gone, the new is here!” (2 Corinthians 5:17)

Temple — “We declare our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit! God lives in us — we are wonderfully His own!” “Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own.” (1 Corinthians 6:19)

Empowered — “We declare the Holy Spirit fills us with power! We are His witnesses, carrying God’s love to the ends of the earth!” “You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and you will be my witnesses to the ends of the earth.” (Acts 1:8)

Purpose — “We declare God has good plans for our lives! He is our hope, and our future is in His loving hands!” “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.” (Jeremiah 29:11)

Commissioned — “We declare Jesus is King over all! He has commissioned us to go and make disciples, sharing His love with every nation!” “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations.” (Matthew 28:18–19)

Presence — “We declare Jesus is with us always, to the very end! We never walk alone — He is right here!” “Surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” (Matthew 28:20)

Possible — We declare all things are possible with God! What seems impossible, He makes wonderfully possible! “With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.” (Matthew 19:26)
